

Bethnal & Bec Dog Policy:

- A MAXIMUM of two well behaved dogs are permitted in the retreat by prior arrangement.
- Dogs should not be left unattended either inside the retreat or in the gardens. Even if your dog is used to being left at home, they can become distressed in unfamiliar surroundings.
- Your private garden is not secure so dogs should be kept on a lead to ensure they do not wander into other gardens.
- Dogs are not allowed on the bed. Your dog can go on the sofa if you have a blanket with you.
- Dogs are strictly prohibited from the hot tub.
- Your dog is free to roam in our one acre paddock. Please note it is not 100% secure and has an entry into our garden which contains our egg machines...ie our free range Ducks and Chickens, if your dog has a high prey drive (like our own dog) and is likely to chase and/or try and eat the wildfowl, please can you keep him on a lead in the Paddock - we also have a lot of wild game here including grouse and pheasant which can send dogs very excitable/make them run off. The paddock leads onto a footpath allowing miles of lovely walks.
- It is your responsibility to clear up all dog mess during, and at the end of, your stay. Bagged waste should be disposed of in the black wheelie bin behind the car port.
- You may not use the bath, shower, towels or robes provided to bathe and dry your dog.
- We provide a dog amenities set for your use, including a small dog bath, portable dog shower, dog shampoo, deodorant, towels and a blanket.
